

## **Beginning Water Media**

\*\*\*\*Provide Your Supplies – If you do not have any yet, please wait to buy them until they are described in the first class session.

Brushes - #12 round watercolor brush and a ½" flat watercolor brush (1" flat suggested)

Paints – Water solvent paints in professional grades. Watercolor: choose Winsor & Newton, Holbein, Da Vinci, Grumbacher, Daniel Smith, etc.

Paint Colors – Alizarin Crimson Permanent, Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow Light,

Raw Sienna, Winsor or Thalo Green, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, Burnt Umber

White non-breakable plate or tray to use as a pallet – at least 10" in diameter

Large Margarine tub or similar size water container

Small box Kleenex

Roll of paper Towels

A Kitchen sponge

Arches watercolor paper – 22 X 30" 140# cold press (I do not recommend watercolor

blocks. Loose sheets are better and cheaper)

A lightweight watercolor board that can hold the paper (plywood, foam core, plastic)
