

Supply List for “Plan Your Paintings for Success” One-Day Class

Painters at all levels in any 2-D medium are welcome.

In this One-Day Class, we will be looking at the ways that the design principles can be applied to artists' compositions to make paintings stronger. Because we will be focusing on design, and not paint application, we will not be doing any painting and all the necessary materials for the class will be supplied by the instructor. It would be helpful, however, if workshop participants could bring

- Scissors
- #2 pencils
- Erasers (kneaded and gum)
- Notebook for taking notes
- Reference Photos: (5) 8”X10” photos you have taken and would like to paint. (No professional photos)
 - Do not crop or manipulate in a paint program.
 - Prints only, no images on smart phone or computer pad. Print as close to 8” X 10” as possible.
 - Try to choose what you genuinely want to paint that has interesting shapes and a range of light to dark.
 - Do not select what you think would be easy—Choose what you find interesting.
- Light Table or light box (if possible): We will bring some light boxes but not enough for everyone so, if you can, please bring one.

If you don't have a light box, don't worry. There will be enough for everyone.
