Picassiette (Broken Dish) Mosaics

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The Creative Arts Center has tools students can use & some substrates (the base to affix mosaic pieces to), as well. If you have material you'd like to use or have your substrate (the base to affix mosaic pieces to) bring that with you to class. But, in the classroom, there is a wealth of material for you to use – tile, glass, dishware, etc. We also have some substrates waiting for you.

For a substrate, you can use wediboard, wood, picture frame, tray, wood/metal cutout, cradleboard, terracotta pots, to name a few.

No need to bring anything to our first class. Look at what's available to you in our classroom then we can discuss what material and substrates you'd like to work with.

Tools (use what's available in the classroom or you can purchase your own at most hardware stores):

2-wheeled nipper

Running Pliers

Compound tile nippers

Glass cutter/scorer
